

MND Victoria have been awarded Commonwealth Home Support Program (CHSP) funds for Minor Home Modifications for clients with Motor Neurone Disease (MND) living in Victoria and Tasmania until 30 June 2022.

MND Victoria are required to adhere to the CHSP Guidelines when administering this Program.

MND Victoria will accept referrals from any qualified registered Allied Health Professionals (from health, community or MND clinic's). Our referral process is available on our website for your therapist to access.

Your Allied Health Professional must have assessed you and your home environment prior to making a referral. They will also need to review the work when it is completed to ensure it is safe for you to use and meets the specification that they requested in the referral.

MND Victoria will accept referrals for people registered with MND, who are over 65 years of age (50 if ATSI/TSI). Each referral must be accompanied by a quote for works and a clear specification of the modification/s required.

People living with MND wishing to access the CHSP granted funds must:

- Be over 65 years or over 50 years if Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander
- Be registered as a member of MND Victoria
- Be living at home in the community within Victoria
- Have the minor home modifications request placed by a qualified Allied Health Professional
